- **Contract-Based Employment:** UMOJI facilitates the placement of trained teams into various contracts, providing them with valuable work experience and income.
- Project & Opportunity Acquisition: Teams will receive projects and opportunities through the SAM Award system and other avenues, expanding their professional horizons and building their portfolios.
- Collaboration with Goodwill: UMOJI seeks to collaborate with Goodwill Employment Opportunities to leverage their expertise in job placement, career development, and community integration.
